## Summary

When natural teeth have to be extracted, tissue volume reconstruction is needed before fixture placement. In traditional way, GBR or even FGG is the regular set, but if we can combine ARP (Alveolar ridge preservation) at the same time when we remove the tooth, process will become easier and more comfortable for both of dentist and patient.

Without tension releasing incision and primary closure, post-op pain and swelling are no longer be patients' nightmare, besides, MGJ keep in the position means no need of FGG and reduce surgery times. But how to manage the socket and choice the martial is the key factors. I will share my experience about whole detail about ARP in this lecture.
